METHODS OF GIVING

CASH GIFTS ... provide immediate help to the Humber College Athletic Program. Gifts in any amounts may be given. Humber College Athletic Fund benefits begin with a minimum contribution of \$25.00. Cheques should be made payable to the Humber College Athletic Fund. Cash gifts may be paid in installments specified by the contributor. A contributor will begin to receive benefits when 50% of the pledge is paid. All contributions are tax deductible.

GIFT-IN-KIND ... can greatly reduce athletic budget expenditures. For some contributors it may be easier to provide goods and services in lieu of a cash gift. Items that normally would be purchased can be a savings to the overall athletic budget i.e. athletic equipment, transportation, hotel rooms, building materials and other commodities.
