

Library Computer Use Policy

- The computers in the Library and Learning Commons are intended for Humber and University of Guelph-Humber students currently enrolled in courses as well as authorized faculty and staff.
- Humber and University of Guelph-Humber Alumni and prospective students with OSAP or application-related questions may access the library computers, subject to availability, for one hour per day. Due to vendor licensing restrictions, alumni and prospective students are not permitted access to online articles, eBooks and streaming videos.
 - Alumni must present their alumni card.
 - Prospective students must show photo ID.
- Community users will not be signed into Humber-managed computers as per Information Technology Services (ITS) directive.
