A welcoming space for kids and adults

Students with child care responsibilities are encouraged to visit the Children's Area on the fourth floor of the North Campus Learning Resource Commons (LRC).

The Children's Area is a special part of the Library. It is designed to provide caregivers and kids with an enjoyable, inviting place to study and play side by side.

This light-filled space is conveniently located near restrooms, the service desk and our collection of children's books. It is equipped with:

- Study tables with electrical outlets and Wi-Fi access
- Child-sized soft seating, tables and chairs
- Knapsacks with giveaways such as small games, puzzles, picture books, colouring kits and crayons
- Child-friendly devices preloaded with entertaining and educational games (available for loan at the circulation desk)

Policies for caregivers

We welcome children of any age under adult supervision. Please note that responsibility rests with the caregiver at all times. The Library team cannot supervise children or be responsible for their safety.
